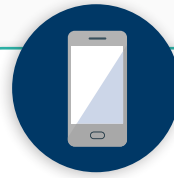
HOW TO FILE

File online 24/7. Service may be limited during nightly system updates. Check website for availability.

INFORMATION YOU'LL NEED FOR YOUR UNEMPLOYMENT APPLICATION

- Your Social Security Number
- Your Driver's License or State ID Number
- Your Name, Address, Telephone Number, & Email Address
- Name, Address, Telephone Number, & Dates of Employment for each Employer you worked for during the past 6 weeks of employment
- The reason you become unemployed from each employer
- Dependents' Names, Social Security Numbers, & Dates of Birth
- If claiming dependents, your spouse's name, Social Security Number, and Date of Birth
- If you are not a US citizen or national, Alien Registration Number and Expiration Date
- Your regular occupation & job skills

ALSO

If you had out-of-state employment, have worked for the federal government, or are separated from military service, you will need:

- Form DD-214, member 4 copy (*for military service*)
- SF-8 or SF-50 form (*for federal government employment*)



ONCE YOUR APPLICATION IS FILED

You will receive further information by mail or email.

Emails will be sent from OJI@odjfs.state.oh.us.

Your claim will be assigned to a Processing Center, based on the last 4 digits of your Social Security Number.
